DR ELLEN BRATEN is an associate professor of psychology at Harvard Medical School and is also a child psychologist at Massachusetts General Hospital where she coordinates the Child Psychology Internship Program. She is the author of a number of books. Her most recent book "Bright Kids Who Can't Keep Up" focuses on the area of cognitive functioning called "processing speed" that often leads to students being mislabeled as lazy or unmotivated.

DR MICHAEL HART is a psychologist who focuses his attention on empowering children and adults with appropriate tools to help them master learning and navigate the world. He has recognized the large gap between diagnosing dyslexia and treating those with learning issues. He pushes the status quo to help bridge the gap between the research on literacy and reading and teacher education.



LALITHA RAMANUJAN has spent the last 30 years helping children with learning difficulties. She is a pioneer in the field of education in South Asia and is the Founder of the Alpha to Omega School in India, where children with learning difficulties have graduated to enroll into tertiary and vocational courses. Her aim has been to help students gain confidence, reach their potential and become independent and active learners.
